

**SEA TEACHER ACTIVITIES CONVERSION GUIDELINES  
CHEMISTRY EDUCATION STUDY PROGRAM  
UNIVERSITAS ISLAM INDONESIA**

The SEA Teacher Project or the “Pre-Service Student Teacher Exchange in Southeast Asia” is a project that aims to provide opportunity for pre-service student teachers from universities in Southeast Asia to have teaching experiences (practicum) in schools in other countries in Southeast Asia. Based on the SEAMEO seven priority areas for the eleven SEAMEO Member countries to work together to improve the quality of education in Southeast Asia, “Revitalizing Teacher Education” is one of the priority areas in building and strengthening capacity of teachers in the region. Students’ roles and responsibilities are assigned weekly during one-month period (observe, assist in teaching, teach and reflect). Moreover, the host universities will provide mentors to supervise and monitor the students throughout the practicum period.

Referring to Rector's Regulations number: 12/PR/REK/20/BPA/IX/2012, Chemistry Education Study Program recognizes student participation in SEA Teacher activities as activities that can be converted into courses. The conversion conditions are as follows:

Total Conversion Credits : 4 Credits  
Converted Courses : Microteaching for Senior High School II  
Field Introduction of School II

The conversion process can only be done with the following conditions:

1. Students fully participate in SEA Teacher activities
2. Attach proof of participation, certificate from The Southeast Asian Ministers of Education Organization (SEAMEO)
3. Attach the supervisor assessment form
